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### **Community-Wide Memorial Service Planned for May**

(Moorestown, NJ) A community-wide Spring Memorial Service is being readied by the grief support team at Moorestown Visiting Nurses & Hospice. The interfaith service will be held on Saturday, May 3 at 10am at Challenge Grove Park Pavilion, Cherry Hill.

The one-hour service will consist of comforting and inspirational readings and activities on the theme of remembrance and renewal led by various representatives of the home care, hospice and community health agency. Central to the service will be the offering of fresh spring flowers in memory of each loved one. After the service, the flowers will be arranged by volunteers, and delivered to the homes of hospice patients to help brighten their day.

Held outdoors under the Challenge Grove Park Pavilion, the open-air service will allow participants a special opportunity to remember and honor lost loved ones. Light refreshments will be offered following the service. (more)
