Moorestown Visiting Nurses & Hospice sets Community “Welcome Day Fair” for September 29

(Moorestown, NJ) Moorestown Visiting Nurses & Hospice recently established new offices in Moorestown at 300 Harper Drive. The organization will be welcoming the community to the grounds of their new facility with a special “Welcome Day Fair” on Saturday, September 29 from noon until 3pm. (Rain date 9/30.) The event is free to the public.

The afternoon will include free games and prizes, food and soft drinks while they last, a children’s craft activity, and more surprises. Mayor Kevin Aberant of Moorestown will be on-hand at 1:00 pm for an “official” ribbon cutting ceremony for the building. Representatives of The Community Counseling Center of Moorestown VNA, a new counseling facility slated to open in September, will be available to answer questions about the services provided.

The public is invited to participate in free blood pressure screenings, and to find out about upcoming flu vaccination clinics. Nurses and other professional staff from the non-profit organization will be on hand to answer questions and to educate about home care and hospice services available to the community.

Other participating organizations include Burlington County Animal Welfare, Brain Injury Association of NJ, Prevention Plus of Burlington County and the Moorestown Police Department.

The September 29 event will be held on the grounds of Moorestown Visiting Nurses & Hospice, 300 Harper Drive, Moorestown. 300 Harper Drive is situated at the corner of Harper Drive and Pleasant Valley Avenue, east of the Moorestown Mall. Vehicles may enter from Harper Drive.
